Our natural materials

Our leather

Our design furniture is made out of 100% natural leather, this leather has been obtained in a socially responsible manner. Every hide is different and has particular characteristics. This also means that our designs could have minor imperfections, which gives our products character and a unique lively appearance. We appreciate these small irregularities, it's simply natural!

The hides arrive in our warehouse and go through an extensive quality check to ensure they're up to standard. Here we check whether the hides don't have big colour differences, stains or holes. Hides that don't fully meet certain criteria aren't thrown out, we use these hides for our Global Balance collection where we turn them into patchwork furniture pieces, placemats, pillows, leather samples or other accessories.

Natural characteristics

Because we use natural materials for our products, there's always a chance that the leather on your product has healed scars, mosquito bites, or pigment stains. Every animal is different, which means that there could also be a difference in the grain and structure of the hide. Due to the different finishing methods, these natural characteristics are easily lost, yet we strive to retain as much of this natural structure as possible. Our leather is unique due to its different natural characteristics.

This also means that colour differences in the leather are normal and to be expected. These variations could occur because each hide reacts differently to the tanning process, absorbing dyes in a unique way. The hide also has natural colour variations, and is unique to the animal. This ensures that every piece of furniture has its own distinct look, enhancing its individuality and charm.

That's just how we do things at Jess!

Leather characteristics

There are different characteristics that are welcomed in our products and which contribute to their lively appearance. Think about neck folds, horn injuries, abrasions, barbed wire damage, rough and manure stains, warts and insect bites. These natural characteristics are allowed to be in the leather on our designs. These characteristics don't lessen the quality of the leather, on the contrary, they ensure that there is a clear visible difference between artificial or synthetic leather and authentic leather.

It's possible for salt stains to form during the tanning process, this is an essential step to prepare the hide for the furnishing process and is due to this also accepted. Hornet bites and other insect bites are often clearly visible on the skin, we do our best to use these parts of the hide in less visible areas of the product. As these are naturally occurring characteristics of a hide, they're allowed to be there, it's simply part of the animal.



Natural characteristics

We embrace the natural characteristics of leather in our furniture. As a natural product, leather carries the story of the animal's life, visible through unique markings such as insect bites, scars, and variations in texture. These features are not imperfections, but rather a testament to the authenticity and individuality of each piece. Our commitment to using high-quality, natural leather ensures that every item of furniture we produce is not only beautiful but also a unique reflection of nature's artistry.

Properties and finish

Our Bonanza leather is made from the top layer of the skin and therefore has a robust and wild appearance. Every animal has its life characteristics reflected in its skin. This also means that every buffalo is unique. The hides are tanned with vegetable substances, after which the grain is manually treated with oil to give the leather a rough character but also to retain its natural characteristics. The Bonanza leather is then treated with aniline dyes so that none of the characteristics of the skin are covered. Due to this natural colouring process, "blemishes" also remain visible, especially in the lighter colours.

Products made from this leather will therefore never be the same. Because as much skin as possible is used, the "stretch" of the skin is also different. In the neck, the leather is much more stiff leaving little to no stretch. When cutting the hides, close attention is paid to what parts of the hide are used for specific parts of the furniture, but that does not mean that this is always processed invisibly. Leather is and remains a natural product. No animal is the same. In addition, due to the nature of the dyeing and tanning method, colour and structure differences can and may occur in each individual hide, as these are characteristic of this special type of leather. Each batch may therefore be different compared to the leather sample in the store or existing showroom models. The leather on one chair may also look different than on one of your other chairs. The leather upholstery on your furniture may also show folds (this can also occur over time). Wrinkling is caused by the natural stretch in the upholstery. This stretch is necessary to prevent too much pressure on the seams, and therefore unnecessary wear. All these properties are part of the natural character of leather and cannot be a reason for complaint.

Properties and finish

The Austrian buffalo is an animal with very distinct features such as protruding bones, a coarse neck, and large horns. Characteristic features of the buffalo hide are insect bites, keratinized spots, manure stains. healed scratches from barbed wire scratches and scars. Aurula combines the finesse of an oil finish with the sturdy, authentic character of the buffalo hide. The hides are mainly dyed with chrome substances, which gives the leather a supple and soft feel. The article is processed with aniline dyes so that none of the characteristics of the skin are covered. The oily touch of the leather is created by the finish with different types of refined oils. The buffalo structure remains clearly visible and gives the leather an extra dimension. The beauty of this leather is the different colour nuances, the beautiful deep colour and the nice supple feel. Leather is and remains a natural product. No animal is the same. In addition, due to the nature of the dyeing and tanning method, colour and structure differences that are characteristic of this special type of leather can and may occur both in each individual hide and in each individual hide. Each batch can therefore be different compared to the leather sample in the store or existing showroom models. The leather on one chair may also look different than on one of your other chairs. The leather upholstery on your furniture may also show folds (this can also occur over time). Wrinkling is caused by the natural stretch in the upholstery. Properties and finish

The Luxor leather is made from Italian cattle and has distinct characteristic features such as insect bites, keratinized spots, manure stains, barbed wire scratches and scars. The vacuum drying preserves the solid fibre structure. The hides are then processed into a crust and a special wax is added to the paint to give the leather a robust appearance. Luxor leather is tumbled in a barrel with high-quality aniline dyes. After finishing, the leather is loosened in a wooden barrel to age the grain. It is then "plated" until a soft and shiny appearance is created. By polishing out the added wax, the aniline and pure character of the leather is emphasised.

The leather does not have a finish which allows the natural appearance such as scratches, mosquito bites and small imperfections to be obscured. It is these irregularities that give this leather its robust and natural character. Leather is a natural product; no animal is the same. In addition, due to the nature of the dyeing and tanning method, colour and structure differences that are characteristic of this special type of leather can and may occur both in each individual hide and in each individual hide. Each batch can therefore be different compared to the leather sample in the store or existing showroom models. The leather on one chair may also look different than on one of your other chairs. The leather upholstery on your furniture may also show folds (this can also occur over time). Wrinkling is caused by the natural stretch in the upholstery. Instructions for use

- Clean soiled leather first with Natural Leather Cleaner! Always test NaturalLeather Wax in an inconspicuous place before use.
- · always try it out on an inconspicuous place first.
- · Apply a thin layer of Natural Leather Wax to a soft, lint-free cloth and rub the surface evenly with a circular motion.
- · Rub in evenly (in a circular motion) and leave to dry for a few minutes.
- Then gently rub the treated surface with a clean cloth.
- \cdot Rub the treated surface with a clean piece of cloth. In case of excessively chalky or dried out furniture, repeat the treatment.
- · Caution! During treatment, some dye may be released on the cloth.

This is a problem for leather with a wax and/or oil layer and has no negative effect on the quality of the leather. (Always treat this type of leather without exerting excessive pressure on it.)

Hold the spray can upright and spray approx. 20 - 30 cm distance in even layers. Drying time approx. 12 hours. The content of the can is sufficient for approx. 5 - 6 m2. Avoid overdosing. Treat your leather Leather Protector every 6 months. Use only in well-ventilated areas! **Vintage Lotion 500 ml:** Test for colour fastness and resistance in an inconspicuous place before use. Only compare after drying. Spray Leather Vintage Lotion onto a clean, lint-free white cloth or flannel. Use it to clean the leather with a flat hand in light, circular movements. Always take a clean part of the cloth. Avoid rubbing too hard. rubbing. If desired, after drying rub the leather lightly with a soft brush or dry white terry cloth.

Sponge: Gently brush until dirt has disappeared and/or the "velvet" appearance has been restored. If necessary, treat with Leather Protector for leather.





Additionally, it's essential to be mindful of the dry atmosphere commonly found in newly constructed homes, as proper insulation can lead to decreased humidity levels.

Our tables are expertly finished with oil, providing protection and enhancing their natural beauty. Regularly treating your table with the recommended oil will help maintain its quality and preserve its appearance for years to come.



Oak

Oakwood is a European hardwood that you can recognise by its light, golden colour and uneven structure. The colour differs a lot from other types of wood. Oakwood, for example, has fewer knots and is heavier than softwood. Oakwood is also recognisable by its straight grain.

The wood is finished with oak oil.



Brushed oak black lacquer

The black oak table top is first brushed, then the wood is finished with a black lacquer. A brushed finish has the benefit of making made scratches less visible.



Walnut

The frames are coloured in a copper bath, after which they are exposed to weather influences to give the copper an authentic appearance. Lastly, they are finished with a clear varnish to make them water- and dirt-repellent as well as colour-retaining. The copper frames can be cleaned with a slightly damp cloth.



Brushed stainless steel

The frames have properties and processing tracks which are characteristic of stainless steel frames. This means that scratches stemming from a light brush during the production process can occur and are allowed. This industrial appearance is inevitably linked to the material's properties and is therefore not grounds for complaints. Stainless steel frames can be cleaned with a slightly damp cloth and if needed, treated with a silicone spray.



Black epoxed

The frames are made out of hot-rolled structural steel and the solid wire is made from hot-rolled solid steel. These hulls go into a phosphate tar tunnel where they change colour, after this the frames are finished with a clear varnish to make them resistant to water and dirt. The frames are painted black with RAL 9005 industrial paint. The black epoxy frames can be cleaned with a slightly damp cloth.
